Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

Dear parish family,

2 Easter A

It is a common experience that when bad things happen, many question the fairness of life and others even question the goodness of God and still others entertain doubt whether there is God who cares. And there are in fact those who are tempted to probe on God. For example there are those who would be saying somehow in this manner, "unless God will give me perfect health, or restore to health my ailing loved one, or unless he will give me blessings of wealth and money, unless my wishes are granted, then I will not believe he cares." These types of mentality resonates that of Thomas in our gospel reading this Sunday, who said, "I cannot believe unless I will see him or put my finger at the wound at his side."

The answer of the Lord is always the same as what he declared to the doubting Thomas. "Put your finger in my nail mark and touch the wound at my side." In a way, He is telling us, "don't tell me that I do not understand your suffering and pains. I suffered even more than you do." And perhaps more profoundly he is telling us in this way, "Understand that every time you suffer, I suffer with you too. Accept the cross the way I do and I will help you through. And together we glorify the Father. Just believe in me, trust me, and do not persist in your unbelief."

The words of the Lord underscore what true faith is, "blest are those who have not seen yet believed." This phrase can be applied in many ways in our faith life. We can apply this to say that blessed are those who believe, love and hold on to the Lord even though they have not tasted the blessings of good health, or have not tasted the blessings of material riches because it means that their faith is not based on the categories of the world, but on the things of the Lord. Or we can apply its meaning to say that blessed are those whose faith remain strong even though they suffer or even though bad things happen. For it means to say that their faith is unshakable and they don't lose hope in God. It means to say that their faith is tested by fire; it is a genuine faith, pure as gold.

There is of course a strong link between inner peace and strong faith. The greater our faith in God, the stronger we are to face and overcome the difficulties, the problems, challenges, and trials that may come along the way.

So as we celebrate the feast of the Divine Mercy this second Sunday of Easter, let us make the habit of praying, "**Jesus I trust in you**" as St. Faustina requested. Indeed, it is in trusting the Lord that gives us inner strength when we are weak and inner peace amidst our world full of troubles.

Querida familia de la parroquia,

2do. Domingo de Pascua A

Es una experiencia común que cuando ocurren cosas malas, muchos cuestionan la justicia de la vida y otros incluso cuestionan la bondad de Dios y todavía otros dudan de si hay Dios que se preocupe. Y de hecho hay quienes están tentados a investigar a Dios. Por ejemplo, hay quienes estarían cuestionándose de esta manera, "a menos que Dios me dé la salud perfecta, o restaure la salud de un ser amado que esté enfermo, que me dé bendiciones de riqueza y dinero, o que mis deseos sean concedidos, no creeré en su presencia. Este tipo de mentalidad resuena la de Tomás en nuestra lectura del evangelio de este domingo, quien dijo: "No puedo creer a menos que yo ponga mi dedo en su llaga y toque la herida de su costado"

La respuesta del Señor es siempre la misma que lo que declaró al incrédulo Tomás. "Pon tu dedo en la marca de mi llaga y toca la herida de mi costado". De alguna manera, Él nos está diciendo, "no me digas que no entiendo tu sufrimiento y dolores. Sufrí aún más que tú. "Y tal vez más profundamente él nos está diciendo de esta manera," Entiende que cada vez que sufres, yo sufro contigo también acepta la cruz como yo, pues estoy contigo. Y juntos glorificamos al Padre. Sólo cree en mí, confía en mí y no persistas en tu incredulidad. "

Las palabras del Señor subrayan lo que es la verdadera fe: "Bienaventurados los que aún no han visto y creen". Esta frase puede aplicarse de muchas maneras en nuestra vida de fe. Podemos aplicar esto para decir que benditos son los que creen, aman y se aferran al Señor aunque no hayan probado las bendiciones de la buena salud, o no hayan recibido las bendiciones de las riquezas materiales porque significa que su fe no está basada sobre las clasificaciones del mundo, sino sobre las cosas del Señor. Podemos aplicar su significado para decir que benditos son aquellos cuya fe permanece fuerte aunque sufren e incluso cuando ocurren cosas malas. Pues quiere decir que su fe es inamovible y no pierden la esperanza en Dios. Significa que su fe es probada por el fuego; Es una fe genuina, pura como el oro.

Hay, por supuesto, un fuerte vínculo entre la paz interior y la fe fuerte. Cuanto mayor sea nuestra fe en Dios, más fuertes estaremos para afrontar y superar las dificultades, los problemas, los desafíos y las pruebas que van a surgir en el camino.

Así como nosotros celebramos la fiesta de la Divina Misericordia este segundo domingo de Pascua, hagamos el hábito de orar, "**Jesús en ti confío**", como pidió Santa Faustina. De hecho, es confiando en el Señor que obtenemos la fuerza interior cuando somos débiles y la paz interior en medio de nuestro mundo lleno de problemas.

¡Bendiciones a ustedes y que tengan una buena semana!
