Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

Dear parish family,

4th Sunday of Easter

This Sunday is traditionally known as the "Good Shepherd Sunday", because on every fourth Sunday of Easter, the gospel selection pertains always on the sayings of Jesus relating himself as the "Good Shepherd". Let us be thankful for all the people who have been good shepherds in our life of faith and pray more for vocations to the priesthood.

We are particularly blessed this week to have a "good shepherd" in the person of **Rev. Fr. William Casey**, CPM, who will conduct our parish mission starting this Sunday. We welcome him in our midst to shepherd us towards a deeper relationship with the Lord Jesus and to refresh ourselves with the renewal of our spiritual life.

Father Casey is a native of Philadelphia who formerly served as an officer in the U.S. Army before becoming a priest. He gave up his military career and entered the Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy (CPM) and has been a member of the community since 1986. He has also served as Superior General of his Congregation from 1997 to 2009. He has worked extensively with Saint Joseph Communications since 1995, and has appeared on Eternal Word Television Network since 1999.

The Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy was founded in 1808 in France for the purpose of evangelizing the French people who were subjected to years of attacks and persecution during the French Revolution. After the suppression and some decades later, many of the priests of the community came to America, and the Fathers of Mercy eventually became an American order.

Father Casey attributes his call to the priesthood to the Divine Mercy, his love for study of Sacred Scriptures, and his strong devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. During the Mission he will challenge the parish community to make a stronger, deeper personal commitment to Christ and His Church. Among the topics he will present during the Mission are the reality of personal sin and the need for sincere conversion and repentance; the biblical and historical foundations of the Mass and the Holy Eucharist; the Blessed Virgin Mary; the power of prayer; the Ten Commandments and the theology of Christian love and morality, and the foundations of the Catholic Church.

He will be speaking for 4 consecutive evenings starting this Sunday till Wednesday. Sessions begins at 7 pm here in the church. This is free of charge, so bring your family and invite as many of your friends and neighbors as well.

Cuarto domingo de Pascua

Este domingo se conoce tradicionalmente como el "Domingo del Buen Pastor", porque cada cuarto domingo de Pascua, las selecciones del evangelio siempre se tratan sobre Jesús y su relación como el "Buen Pastor." Demos gracias por todas las personas que han sido buenos pastores en nuestras vidas de fe y oremos por más vocaciones sacerdotales.

Estamos particularmente bendecidos esta semana en tener un "buen pastor" en la persona del Rev. Fr. William Casey, CPM, quien conducirá nuestra misión parroquial comenzando este domingo. Le damos la bienvenida para pastorearnos en una relación más profunda con el Señor Jesús y para refrescarnos en una nueva vida espiritual.

El Padre Casey es de Philadelphia y sirvió como oficial en el Army de los Estados Unidos antes de ser sacerdote. El dejó su carrera militar y entro en la Congregación de los Padres de Misericordia (CPM) y ha sido un miembro de la comunidad desde 1986. También sirvió como Superior General de su Congregación de 1997 – 2009. Él ha trabajado extensivamente con las Comunicaciones de San José desde 1995, y ha salido en Eternal Word Televisión Network desde 1999.

La Congregación de los Padres de Misericordia fue fundada en 1808 en Francia con el propósito de evangelizar a los franceses quienes fueron atacados y perseguidos por años durante la Revolución Francesa. Unas décadas después de la supresión muchos de los sacerdotes llegaron a América, y los Padres de Misericordia se convirtieron en una orden Americana.

El Padre Casey atribuya su llamado al sacerdocio a la Divina Misericordia, su amor al Estudio de los Evangelios, y su gran devoción al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús y al Inmaculado Corazón de María. Durante la Misión el desafiara a la comunidad en tener un compromiso y relación más personal a Cristo y Su Iglesia. Algunos de los temas que presentara durante la Misión son la realidad del pecado personal y la necesidad de una sincera conversión y arrepentimiento; la fundación histórica y bíblica de la Misa y la Santa Eucaristía; la Santísima Virgen María; el poder de la oración; los Diez Mandamientos y la teología moral del amor Cristiano, y la fundación de la Iglesia Católica.

El estará hablando por 4 noches seguidas comenzando este domingo hasta el miércoles. Las sesiones comenzaran a las 7 p.m. aquí en la Iglesia. Esto es gratuito, así que traigan a toda la familia e inviten a todos sus amigos y vecinos también.
