Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

23 Sunday A

Greetings of peace and love!

Two weeks has passed after Harvey wrecked tremendous damage to our beloved State. The terrible after affects are still fresh and for so many the tasks of rebuilding and recovery world take a long way. But in times like these, we become stronger and better as individuals and as a community. We suffer together with others and when we take our crosses together they become lighter.

We give appreciation and admiration for those who literally lend a hand to uplift the burdens of others. That includes many in our parish family who did and still doing individually in their own initiatives. We thank the leadership of Shari Davis and the Li9fe Teen collect items for the shelters, and the so many others in our parish.

But it takes billions of dollars for the extensive and long term recovery efforts. We do our part collectively as a parish. We'll have two Sundays of collection for disaster relief it's because we already have a pre-assigned second collection this Sunday. So this Sunday we'll divide the second collection; the pre-assigned envelopes for Catholic Universities and the cash for the disaster relief. But next Sunday will just be exclusively for disaster relief. So be generous.

If we take a message from the readings this Sunday that we can relate to our efforts, it must be from second the second reading. Stj. Paul tells us that we owe nothing to anyone except one that binds us to love one another for love does no wrong to the neighbor. True love is not passive. Love demands that we speak and do what is true and good for the other.

True love therefore is the only measure we can deal with wrong things going around us and correct them in a right way. True love has the real power to transform. It is not happy with the wrong things and aims only what is good.

The context of all our Sunday readings is actually about fraternal correction. But it is significant that after Jesus gave his teaching about fraternal correction on this Sunday's gospel, he said, "When one or two are gathered in my name I am their midst." This emphasizes not only the presence of Christ in the community at prayer but also of the power of community that are bound together for the purposes of God

We are reminded of the old saying, "the family that prays together stays together. " When a family prays together the bond with each other is much stronger and more strengthen as they broaden the connection to the bigger family of faith.
