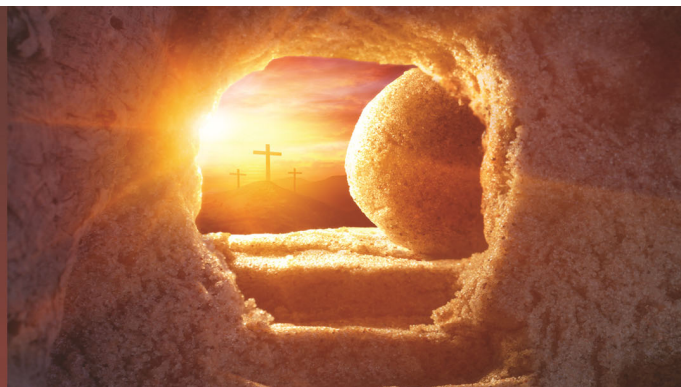

### Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

### Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

### Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup> Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

### Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

### Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

**Dear parish family,**

**3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday Easter B**

This weekend we continue to bask in the light and the glory of Easter.

In our Gospel this Sunday Jesus' disciples are troubled, still terrified, they thought they were seeing a ghost. They don't yet comprehend meaning of Jesus' Resurrection. They still don't understand the Scriptures. They'll need some time. They'll need some work. So we begin to see Jesus appearing to them, clearing up their thinking and preparing them to carry on. He had chosen them because of their potential. That potential to be the bearers of the Good News. Their witness, in their humanity, would convince others that the Resurrection was real. They couldn't help but see the changes in their lives. Something incredible was happening, that's for sure.

As Jesus' disciples today we too are sent forth to bring the Good News to others. We'll spread the Good News among our own family members and friends. How powerful would it be if we'd pay such close attention to the Commandments that we'd never gossip again? If we'd truly honor our parents, listen to them and seek their guidance? If we'd be happy with our own lives and possessions without craving more? If we'd live respectfully and honestly? What if we'd leave the hurts of the past behind and never mention them again? Wouldn't that set a powerful example for our children, our family members and friends, our community?

It's up to us now, to spread the Good News of Jesus' resurrection. This week we can take the message of the Scriptures seriously. We can do that if we don't shrink from speaking about our faith ... and if we summon the courage to truly live it. Let's be faithful to that call.

Like those disciples who encountered the Risen Lord, we have to experience our own "encounter" with the presence of the Lord in whatever way it comes. May not be that dramatic or mysterious but happens so many times, at our private prayers, at Eucharist, or in our deep meditation on Scriptures. And it is worth asking ourselves if this experience of our personal "encounter" with the Risen Christ is clearly seen in our daily actions.

En nuestro Evangelio de este domingo, los discípulos de Jesús están preocupados, todavía aterrorizados, creyeron ver un fantasma. Todavía no comprenden el significado de la Resurrección de Jesús. Ellos todavía no entienden las Escrituras. Necesitarán algo de tiempo. Necesitarán un poco de trabajo. Entonces comenzamos a ver a Jesús apareciéndose a ellos, aclarando sus pensamientos y preparándolos para continuar. Él los había elegido debido a su potencial. Esa expectativa para ser portadores de las Buenas Nuevas. Su testimonio, en su humanidad, convencería a otros de que la Resurrección era real. Definitivamente no pudieron evitar ver los cambios en sus vidas. Algo increíble estaba sucediendo, eso era por seguro.

Como discípulos de Jesús hoy, también nosotros somos enviados a llevar las Buenas Nuevas a otros. Depende de nosotros ahora, difundir las Buenas Nuevas de la resurrección de Jesús. Esta semana podemos tomar en serio el mensaje de las Escrituras. Podemos hacer eso si no nos avergonzamos de hablar sobre nuestra fe... y si reunimos el coraje para vivirlo de verdad. Seamos fieles a esa llamada.

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office. “Protecting God’s Children’s” is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff, and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and how to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God’s children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

“Protecting God’s Children” workshops are held throughout the Archdiocese. If you plan on volunteering here at St. Mary’s and have not taken this class, please see the list of area churches offering the training listed below. All attendees must have a current Driver’s license (any state), State-issued Identification Card, Passport (any country), Mexico or Guatemala Consulate ID in order to attend a “Protecting God’s Children” Workshop.
