Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

The Good Shepherd Sunday

As we celebrate "Good Shepherd Sunday," let us all strive that we may be His good sheep, listening attentively to His guiding voice, and follow His example of self-giving love.

Each church community is a flock. And we as members of that flock have to promote harmony and unity in the community so that its members feel comfortable and happy within it. All together, we will have to strengthen it. So, when the wolves come (they come in my guises) and want to snatch us from our Church and our faith, they will not be able to take away even one sheep. With unity and good harmony we will be able to maintain, for Christ, one flock under one shepherd.

Our Christian calling is also to be "good shepherds" ourselves for each other in our inter-personal relationships with others and more importantly in our family relations. When we are shepherding each other in love and commitment then we can be sure we can find life more meaningful and wonderful.

This Sunday is also World Day of Prayer for Vocations. We are asked to pray hard for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. More powerful than prayer is example. To foster vocations, the family must foster the Christian life. The seed of vocations can grow in the loving and truly religious family and its extension, which is the parish family. Children and youth are inspired by good role models in their faith community. Good fruits come from good trees.

We can safely say that good parenting, which is literally good shepherding, is the most crucial. No amount of church program can do much greater job than good Christian parenting. About 80 percent of what the person is depends on how the person is reared up from childhood to his youth and how the faith is nurtured in the domestic church which we call home. The church community is the support and has the secondary shepherding role – the primary task belongs to the parents where they are everyday.

May all of us be "good shepherds", in whatever vocation of life we are called, following the example of our eternal Good Shepherd, our Lord Jesus.

Querida familia de la parroquia,

Domingo del Buen Pastor

Al celebrar el "Domingo del Buen Pastor", procuremos todos ser su buena oveja, escuchando atentamente su voz guiadora y siguiendo su ejemplo de amor que se entrega a sí mismo.

Cada comunidad de iglesia es un rebaño. Y nosotros, como miembros de esa bandada, tenemos que promover la armonía y la unidad en la comunidad para que sus miembros se sientan cómodos y felices dentro de ella. Todos juntos, tendremos que fortalecernos. Entonces, cuando vengan los lobos (vienen bajo mi apariencia) y quieran arrebatarlos de nuestra Iglesia y nuestra fe, no podrán quitar ni una sola oveja. Con unidad y buena armonía podremos mantener, para Cristo, un rebaño bajo un solo pastor.

Nuestra vocación cristiana también es ser "buenos pastores" entre nosotros en nuestras relaciones interpersonales con los demás y, lo que es más importante, en nuestras relaciones familiares. Cuando nos guiamos unos a otros en amor y compromiso, podemos estar seguros de que podemos encontrar la vida más significativa y maravillosa.

Este domingo también es el Día Mundial de Oración por las Vocaciones. Se nos pide orar mucho por las vocaciones al sacerdocio y la vida religiosa. Más poderoso que la oración es un ejemplo. Para fomentar las vocaciones, la familia debe fomentar la vida cristiana. La semilla de las vocaciones puede crecer en la familia amorosa y verdaderamente religiosa y su extensión, que es la familia parroquial. Los niños y jóvenes se inspiran en buenos modelos de conducta en su comunidad de fe. Los buenos frutos provienen de buenos árboles.

Podemos decir con seguridad que una buena crianza, que es literalmente un buen pastoreo, es la más importante. Ninguna cantidad de programa de la iglesia puede hacer un trabajo mucho mejor que una buena crianza cristiana. Alrededor del 80 por ciento de lo que la persona es depende de cómo la persona se cría desde la infancia hasta su juventud y cómo la fe se nutre en la iglesia doméstica que llamamos hogar. La comunidad de la iglesia es el soporte y tiene el rol secundario de pastoreo: la tarea principal corresponde a los padres donde están todos los días.

Que todos seamos "buenos pastores", en cualquier vocación de vida que se nos llame, siguiendo el ejemplo de nuestro Buen Pastor eterno, nuestro Señor Jesús.

Preventing child sexual abuse is the goal of the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Office. “Protecting God’s Children’s” is the program selected by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston to educate clergy, staff, and volunteers who work with children and youth about child sexual abuse and the ways to create a safe environment for children. The 3-hour live session includes videos and facilitated discussions that focus on the prevention of abuse and the protection of children. Adults learn how to recognize the warning signs of sexual abuse and how to respond appropriately. You will learn about steps that the faith community can take to create a safe environment for all God’s children and how to respond when adults behave in a way that raises concerns.

“Protecting God’s Children” workshops are held throughout the Archdiocese. If you plan on volunteering here at St. Mary’s and have not taken this class, please see the list of area churches offering the training listed below. All attendees must have a current Driver’s license (any state), State-issued Identification Card, Passport (any country), Mexico or Guatemala Consulate ID in order to attend a “Protecting God’s Children” Workshop. When pre-registering for the class, YOU MUST USE YOUR NAME and DATE OF BIRTH as it appears on your DL, ID, or Passport. Please pre-register online at www.virtusonline.org No walk-ins accepted.

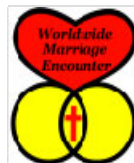
