**Sacrament of Baptism**

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

**Reconciliation**

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

**Sacrament of Marriage**

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

**Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults**

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1<sup>st</sup> Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

**Sacrament of First Communion**

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

**Sacrament of Confirmation**

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

**Dear parish family,**

**Pentecost Sunday**

Our faith is not something we need to hoard and treat as a fragile heirloom. Instead, we have the breathing, energizing, encouraging and border-busting life of God with us as we gather in prayer and discern how we are to be church in the world.

This Sunday we observe the first fruits of the Spirit at Pentecost as the disciples immediately break out of their confines to preach to a crowd that represents the multi-lingual world they will go out to preach to. The Acts of the Apostles reveals how the early church devolved from a small community of Jesus' Jewish followers into a Christian community expressing his love, peace, forgiveness and healing to the world. They were so permeated by the Holy Spirit that there was no room for fear.

We know how deeply we need the Holy Spirit in our life as a church and as individuals in today's world. We face a world of unbelief, cynicism, disillusionment and spiritual depletion. We could hunker down and "keep the faith," or we could do what first community did as they receive the Spirit: step confidently out into the world and speak the Good News to the confused crowd they encounter.

Somehow we know our limitations and can predict, we think, how we will fall short in the witnessing profession to which the Spirit has called us. But we are reminded today also of the same limitations the first disciples and how they were changed by the Spirit. We should believe the same Spirit is still with us and ready to embolden us when we asked this gift to strengthen and renew us.

We are called to open our hands and our hearts and receive those same gifts God gave Jesus' disciples. This week we can take a look at our fears and pray for the willingness to let go of them, and to let God fill that place within us with God's peace and strength. We can invite the Lord into the areas of our hardness of heart that we might be filled with the peace God wants us to have.

On this Pentecost we ask Jesus to breathe his Spirit on us. We have to believe that on this Pentecost Jesus will breathe on us anew, because these days we are like distant runners gasping for air. Who knows how far we still have to go?

St. Thomas Aquinas once said that if the Holy Spirit is described in the Scriptures coming down as a driving wind then we are his sailboats. Just as a sailboat cannot move onwards without opening its sails, we too cannot move in grace if we don't open wide our personal life to the Spirit. Today therefore we are reminded to open ourselves wide to the winds of the Holy Spirit. And if we do this, then we will be astonished of what it can accomplish in us.

**Querida familia parroquial,**

**Domingo de Pentecostés**

Nuestra fe es algo que no necesitamos acumular y tratar como una herencia frágil. En su lugar, tenemos la vida de Dios que respira, energiza, alienta y que rompe toda frontera entre nosotros cuando nos reunimos en oración y discernimos cómo debemos de ser la iglesia en el mundo

Este domingo observamos los primeros frutos del Espíritu en Pentecostés cuando los discípulos salen de sus confines para predicar a una multitud que representa el mundo multilingüe al que predicarán. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles revelan cómo la iglesia primitiva pasó de ser una pequeña comunidad Judía seguidores de Jesús a una comunidad cristiana que expresa su amor, paz, perdón y sanación al mundo. Estaban tan impregnados por el Espíritu Santo que no había lugar para el temor.

Sabemos cuán profundamente necesitamos al Espíritu Santo en nuestra vida como iglesia y como individuos en el mundo de hoy. Nos enfrentamos a un mundo de incredulidad, cinismo, desilusión y agotamiento espiritual. Podríamos agacharnos y "mantener la fe", o podríamos hacer lo que la primera comunidad hizo cuando recibieron el Espíritu: caminar con confianza hacia el mundo y hablar la Buena Nueva a la multitud confusa que encontraron.

De alguna manera conocemos nuestras limitaciones. Pero hoy nos recuerdan las mismas limitaciones de los primeros discípulos y cómo fueron cambiados por el Espíritu. Debemos creer que el mismo Espíritu está todavía con nosotros y listo para incentivarnos cuando pedimos este don y así fortalecernos y renovarnos.

Estamos llamados a abrir nuestras manos y nuestros corazones y recibir los mismos dones que Dios dio a los discípulos de Jesús. Esta semana podemos echar un vistazo a nuestros temores y orar para librarnos de ellos, y dejar que Dios llene ese lugar dentro de nosotros con la paz y la fuerza de Dios. Podemos invitar al Señor a las áreas de nuestra dureza de corazón para que podamos estar llenos de la paz que Dios quiere que tengamos.

En este Pentecostés le pedimos a Jesús que envíe su Espíritu sobre nosotros. Tenemos que creer que en este Pentecostés Jesús soplara de nuevo, ya que en estos días somos como corredores distantes jadeando por aire.

¿Quién sabe hasta qué punto tenemos que ir?

Santo Tomás de Aquino dijo una vez que si el Espíritu Santo se describe en las Escrituras que bajan como un viento impulsor, entonces somos sus veleros. Así como un velero no puede avanzar sin abrir sus velas, nosotros tampoco podemos movernos en gracia si no abrimos nuestra vida personal al Espíritu. Hoy nos recuerda que debemos abrirnos a los vientos del Espíritu Santo. Y si hacemos esto, entonces nos sorprenderemos de lo que se puede lograr en nosotros.
