Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

Dear parish family,

CORPUS CHRISTI

Vatican II calls the Eucharist "the font and summit of Christian life". Surely we can't cover in few lines the depth in meaning of the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ which the Church celebrates this Sunday. So let me just highlight 3 points.

1) Unity and sacrificial love: The Eucharist teaches us the importance of community, the bond that results from this sacrifice. Just as numerous grains of wheat are pounded together to make the host, and many grapes are crushed together to make the wine, so we become unified in this sacrifice. Our Lord chose these elements in order to show us that we ought to seek union with one another, to allow the Holy Spirit to transform us into Our Lord Jesus Christ and to work with Him in the process. Christ is the Head and we are the Body. Together we are one. That which unites us is our willingness to sacrifice our time and talents to God in our fellow members in Christ's Mystical Body. This is symbolized by our sharing in the same Bread and the same Cup. Hence, Holy Communion should strengthen our sense of unity and love.

2) We need to prepare properly to receive Holy Communion: We have tarnished God's image within us through acts of impurity, disobedience and the like. Let us therefore receive Holy Communion with fervent love and respect -- not merely as a matter of routine. We need to be reminded that our outward piety towards the consecrated Bread and Wine cannot coexist with rudeness, unkindness, slander, cruelty, gossiping or any other breach of charity toward our brothers and sisters.

3) We need to become Christ-bearers and conveyers: We are what we eat. By receiving Holy Communion we become Christ-bearers as Mary was, with the duty of conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, as love, mercy, forgiveness and humble and sacrificial service.

As we therefore celebrate this great feast of faith, let us worship what St. Thomas Aquinas did not hesitate to call, "the greatest miracle that Christ ever worked on earth My Body My Blood". Before the greatness of this mystery, let us also repeat St. Thomas Aquinas' prayer of devotion in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament: "O Sacrament most holy! O Sacrament Divine! All praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine!"

On a different note, please keep me in your prayers as I'll undergo a heart bypass surgery this Thursday, June 22. Other priests will be covering me until I'll fully recuperate.

Querida familia parroquial,

CORPUS CHRISTI

El Vaticano II llama a la Eucaristía "la fuente y la cumbre de la vida cristiana". Seguramente no podemos cubrir en pocas líneas la profundidad en el significado de la Solemnidad del Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo que la Iglesia celebra este domingo. Así que permítanme simplemente destacar 3 puntos.

1) Unidad y amor de sacrificio: La Eucaristía nos enseña la importancia de la comunidad, el vínculo que resulta de este sacrificio. Así como numerosos granos de trigo se trituran para hacer la hostia, y muchas uvas se exprimen para hacer el vino, así nos unificarnos en este sacrificio. Nuestro Señor escogió estos elementos y así mostrarnos que debemos buscar la unión unos con otros, para permitir que el Espíritu Santo nos transforme en Nuestro Señor Jesucristo y poder trabajar con Él en el proceso. Cristo es la Cabeza y nosotros somos el Cuerpo. Juntos somos uno. Lo que nos une es la disposición a sacrificar nuestro tiempo y talentos hacia Dios a favor de nuestros compañeros en el Cuerpo Místico de Cristo. Esto es simbolizado por nuestro compartir en el mismo Pan y la misma Copa. Por lo tanto, la Santa Comunión debe fortalecer nuestro sentido de unidad y amor.

2) Necesitamos prepararnos adecuadamente para recibir la Sagrada Comunión: Hemos empañado la imagen de Dios dentro de nosotros a través de actos de impureza, desobediencia y cosas por el estilo. Por lo tanto, recibamos la Sagrada Comunión con ferviente amor y respeto - no sólo como una cuestión de rutina. Debemos recordar que nuestra piedad exterior hacia el pan y el vino consagrados no puede coexistir con la rudeza, la crueldad, la calumnia, la deshonestidad, el chisme o cualquier otra falta de caridad hacia nuestros hermanos y hermanas.

3) Necesitamos ser receptores y portadores de Cristo: Somos lo que comemos. Al recibir la Santa Comunión nos convertimos en portadores de Cristo como lo fue María, con el deber de transmitir a Cristo a los demás en el hogar y en el lugar de trabajo, con amor, misericordia, perdón, servicio humilde y sacrificado.

Por lo tanto, al celebrar esta gran fiesta de fe, adoremos lo que Santo Tomás de Aquino no vaciló en llamar "el milagro más grande que Cristo haya dejado en la tierra ... Mi Cuerpo ... " Mi sangre". Ante la grandeza de este misterio, repitamos también la oración de devoción de Santo Tomás de Aquino en presencia del Santísimo Sacramento: "¡Oh Sacramento Santo, oh Sacramento Divino!, ¡toda la honra, toda la gloria y toda la acción de gracias sean tuyos!"

Cambiando de tema, por favor les pido que me mantengan en sus oraciones ya que me someteré a una cirugía de bypass este jueves 22 de junio. Otros sacerdotes me cubrirán hasta que me recuperen completamente.
