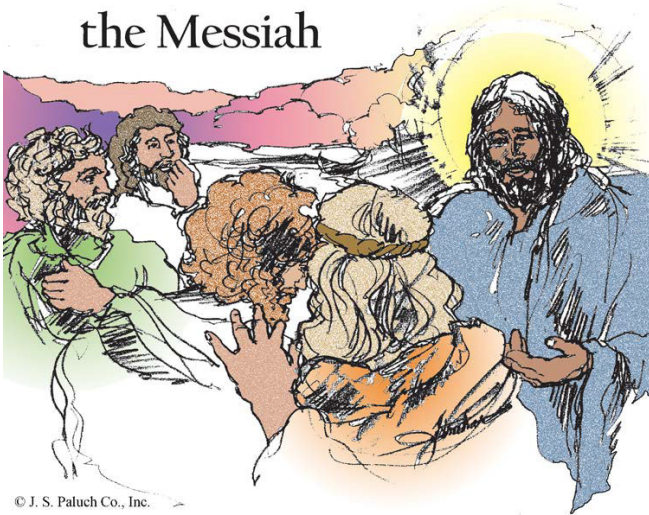

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

Dear parish family,

2 Sunday Ordinary Time

The church year has moved now into "Ordinary Time". We are no longer visiting the manger, but in just a couple of months or more we will be visiting the empty tomb. In the meantime we are moving along the normality of the days. And it is appropriate that this Sunday's readings call our attention on the call of the Lord for each of us.

Samuel's life (first reading) was transformed when he responded to God. So too were Andrew's, John's, and Simon Peter's when they decided to follow Jesus. By giving themselves over to the Lord, they are no longer living for themselves.

Jesus asks these first two disciples an important and a logical question: "What are you looking for?" It is the same question He asks of all of us. For the answer the Lord directed them, as He does us as well, to Himself – to live with Him, to "Come and...see." Those disciples followed Him.

All of us are disciples of the Lord today and we tried our best to answer the call to follow him in our particular vocation in life. Our answer may not be as dramatic compared to the first disciples, or perhaps those today who give their lives completely to serve God in church ministry. Yet our responses to the call of the Lord can be heard in different corners and various aspects of our life. Those maybe are loud and clear at home, at work, or at recreation when we need to follow the Lord than to follow the ways of the world. Or maybe the voice of the Lord may call us for some needs of our parish life. Maybe the Lord is calling you to stay with him for an hour at Adoration chapel to be his or her prayer warriors.

One in particular who answered the call to serve our parish is **Randy Tercero**. Let us welcome him as our new EDGE Coordinator. And let's give him our wholehearted support in this ministry. Actually he and his wife had been the volunteer Core Team members of the EDGE for the past two years. He is our logical choice to replace Renee Cortez who sadly has health issues and can longer serve as Coordinator as she used to be. We greatly appreciate her work for the past years and so grateful for her exemplary service. Let's keep both of them in our prayers.

We hear of how Samuel answered the call of God in our first reading this Sunday and his response has become the subject of numerous hymns and other writings. Twice Samuel says "Here I am," and then declares, "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening." One of the more popular hymns has as its refrain, "Here I am Lord; is it I Lord? I have heard You calling in the night. I will go Lord, if You lead me. I will hold Your people in my heart."

Samuel response captures the essence of what our response to God's call should be. Do we respond as definitely as Samuel does? That is what we are called to do.

Querida familia de la parroquia,

2 Domingo Tiempo Ordinario

El año de la iglesia se ha movido ahora al "Tiempo ordinario". Ya no estamos visitando el pesebre, pero en solo un par de meses más o menos visitaremos la tumba vacía. Mientras tanto nos estamos moviendo a lo largo de la normalidad de los días. Y es apropiado que las lecturas de este domingo llamen nuestra atención sobre el llamado del Señor para cada uno de nosotros.

La vida de Samuel (primera lectura) se transformó cuando él respondió a Dios. También lo fueron Andrew, John y Simón Pedro cuando decidieron seguir a Jesús. Al seguir al Señor, ya no viven para sí mismos.

Jesús interroga a estos dos primeros discípulos con una pregunta muy importante y lógica: "¿Qué estás buscando?" Es la misma pregunta que Él nos hace a todos. Esperando la respuesta que el Señor los dirigió a ellos, como a nosotros también, - a vivir con Él, a "Venir y ... ver". Esos discípulos lo siguieron.

Todos nosotros somos discípulos del Señor hoy y hacemos todo lo posible para responder al llamado a seguirlo en nuestra vocación particular en la vida. Nuestra respuesta puede no ser tan dramática comparada con los primeros discípulos, o quizás aquellos que hoy dan sus vidas por completo para servir a Dios en el ministerio de la iglesia. Sin embargo, nuestras respuestas al llamado del Señor se pueden escuchar en diferentes rincones y en diversos aspectos de nuestra vida. Debiendo ser convincentes y transparentes en casa, en el trabajo o en las actividades recreativas cuando necesitamos seguir al Señor y no seguir los caminos del mundo. O tal vez la voz del Señor puede llamarnos para algunas necesidades de nuestra vida parroquial. Tal vez el Señor te está llamando para que te quedes con él durante una hora en la capilla de la Adoración y así ser su guerrero de oración.

Uno en particular que respondió el llamado para servir a nuestra parroquia es Randy Tercero. Démosle la bienvenida como nuestro nuevo coordinador de EDGE. Y démosle nuestro apoyo incondicional en este ministerio. En realidad, él y su esposa habían sido los miembros voluntarios del Equipo Central de EDGE durante los últimos dos años. Él es nuestra opción lógica para reemplazar a René Cortez, quien lamentablemente tiene problemas de salud y puede servir como Coordinadora como solía ser. Te he oído llamarme en la noche. Iré a ti Señor, si Tú me guías. Mantendré a tu pueblo en mi corazón".

La respuesta de Samuel captura la esencia de lo que debería ser nuestra respuesta al llamado de Dios. ¿Respondemos completamente como lo hace Samuel? Eso es lo que estamos llamados a hacer.

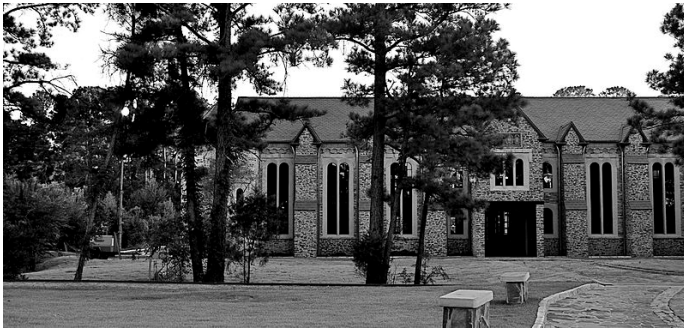
