Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are celebrated on the 1st Sunday of the month. Classes are held on the 2nd & 3rd Tuesday of each month. Please come by the Parish Office to register or call for more information.

Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Penance is offered on Saturdays, from 4:30p.m. to 5:30p.m. or by appointment.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the Parish Office at least (6) six months prior to your desired wedding date to arrange a meeting with Father Tony or one of the Deacons. If you want a Mass, you must call Father Tony.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

Are you a non-Catholic who is interested in joining the Catholic faith? Are you a baptized Catholic who has never received the sacraments of 1st Communion and Confirmation? If your answer is yes to either of these questions, call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of First Communion

First Communion candidates must be baptized, at least in the second grade, and have been attending CCE classes for two full years previous to their receiving the Sacrament. Adults needing First Communion should refer to the rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Confirmation candidates must have previously received the Sacraments of Baptism and First Communion. They must have faithfully attended Life Teen for at least one full year prior to beginning preparation for the Sacrament (more than three absences without a valid excuse can alter the process). A signed form stating that the parent/guardian and the candidate understand all requirements is also necessary before the preparation begins. Adults needing confirmation should refer to the Rite of Christian initiation of adults.

Dear parish family,

3rd Sunday B

The Scriptures for these first weeks in Ordinary Time speak to our hearts in a powerful way. This Sunday's gospel shows Jesus doing what he came to earth to do: calling people into a personal relationship with God. That's really the core of what Christianity is all about.

What happened in this Sunday's Gospel passage happens to each one of us throughout our lives. Peter, Andrew, James, and John were all living their normal lives, working to keep food on the table. They were indistinguishable from any of their contemporaries, so plainly ordinary people. But then one day Jesus Christ walked into their midst and called them each by name. Jesus didn't see them as average people, simple fishermen. Jesus saw each one in the revealing light of God's love.

And just as he invited each one of them to join his team and share his mission, so he does with us. All of us, without exception, are called by the Lord in the words he said to his Apostles: "Come with me." A few chosen responded as special agents, as priests, religious, and missionaries. But to most of us he calls to the "mission" in our particular vocations - to be his ambassadors in the middle of our normal family and work life, redeeming the world from within, like leaven in the dough.

Have we stopped to think that we are the instruments through which God uses to build his Kingdom in our lives and in our society? Every time we have the challenge and commitment to transform darkness into light, sin into grace, pain into joy, war into peace and transforming everything around us in the way of Jesus we are building God's kingdom.

Are we aware that by fighting against the darkness in our family and our hearts and bringing the light of our faith to our homes and to our hearts we are building the Kingdom of God?

Every time we heal the pain of a friend, every time we know how to listen and put ourselves in their place, we are building the Kingdom.

Every time we help others to see clearly the way of God, God is building his Kingdom through us.

Every time we visit a sick person and bring him consolation and companionship, we are healing his heart with the strength of the Kingdom that is being built at that moment.

Every time we give love, we are actually dispensing the power of God's love. Each time we give testimony of our faith, we are building the Kingdom. Let's not forget that our faith is stronger than we think. And indeed, as the gospel says, "The kingdom of God is at hand... time of fulfillment has come!" It is within our grasp and just a matter of our response to his call to follow him.

Las Escrituras de estas primeras semanas en el Tiempo Ordinario hablan a nuestros corazones de una manera poderosa. El evangelio de este domingo muestra a Jesús haciendo a lo que vino a la tierra: llamar a las personas a una relación personal con Dios. Ese es realmente el núcleo de lo que se trata el cristianismo.

Lo que sucedió en el pasaje del Evangelio de este domingo nos sucede a cada uno de nosotros a lo largo de nuestras vidas. Peter, Andrew, James y John estaban viviendo su vida normal, trabajando para llevar la comida a la mesa. Eran indistinguibles de cualquiera de sus contemporáneos, gente tan sencillamente ordinaria. Pero luego, un día, Jesucristo entró en medio de ellos y los llamó a cada uno por su nombre. Jesús no los veía como personas comunes, simples pescadores. Jesús vio a cada uno en la luz reveladora del amor de Dios.

Y al igual que invitó a cada uno de ellos a unirse a su equipo y compartir su misión, también lo hace con nosotros. Todos nosotros, sin excepción, somos llamados por el Señor en las palabras que dijo a sus Apóstoles: "Vengan conmigo". Unos pocos elegidos respondieron como agentes especiales, como sacerdotes, religiosos y misioneros. Pero para la mayoría de nosotros él llama a la "misión" en nuestras vocaciones particulares: ser sus embajadores en medio de nuestra vida normal familiar y laboral, redimir al mundo desde adentro, como levadura en la masa.

¿Nos hemos detenido a pensar que somos los instrumentos a través de los cuales Dios usa para construir su Reino en nuestras vidas y en nuestra sociedad? Cada vez que tenemos el desafío y el compromiso de transformar la oscuridad en luz, el pecado en la gracia, el dolor en la alegría, la guerra en la paz y la transformación de todo lo que nos rodea, en el camino de Jesús, estamos construyendo el reino de Dios.

¿Somos conscientes de que luchando contra la oscuridad en nuestra familia y nuestros corazones y llevando la luz de nuestra fe a nuestros hogares y a nuestros corazones estamos construyendo el Reino de Dios?

Cada vez que sanamos el dolor de un amigo, cada vez que sabemos escuchar y ponernos en su lugar, estamos construyendo el Reino.

Cada vez que ayudamos a otros a ver claramente el camino de Dios, Dios está construyendo su Reino a través de nosotros.

Cada vez que visitamos a una persona enferma y le brindamos consuelo y compañerismo, estamos sanando su corazón con la fuerza del Reino que se está construyendo en ese momento.

Cada vez que damos amor, en realidad estamos dispensando el poder del amor de Dios. Cada vez que damos testimonio de nuestra fe, estamos construyendo el Reino. No olvidemos que nuestra fe es más fuerte de lo que pensamos. Y de hecho, como dice el evangelio, "El reino de Dios está a la mano ... ha llegado el momento de darnos cuenta! "Está a nuestro alcance y solo es una cuestión de nuestra respuesta a seguir su llamado.

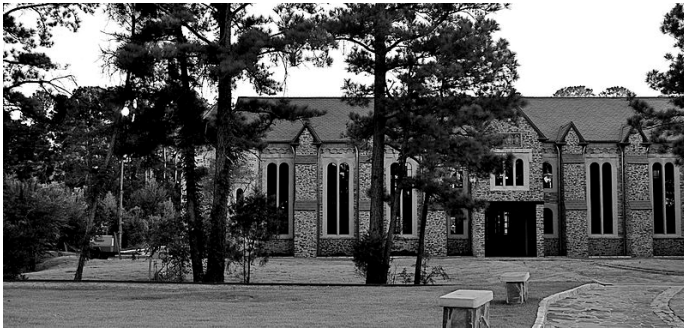
